- PASS CARD TRAVEL

- Free shuttle buses between the BWI train station and the BWI Airport terminals operate every 12-25 minutes daily. Buses stop adjacent to the rail station garage directly across from the station building.
- eTickets for **Reserved services** are valid only for the specific train number, date and accommodation type booked.
- When should you arrive at the station? Check the recommended arrival times for your departure station at [Amtrak.com/stations](http://Amtrak.com/stations). Allow additional time if you require ticketing/baggage services or boarding assistance, or if you are boarding at a Canadian station.
- **Thanksgiving Travel Tips:** Expect crowds at the station and onboard trains during the busy Thanksgiving travel period. Allow yourself plenty of time at the station to check your bags (if service is available) and find your train. Space onboard will be at a premium, so make sure your carry-ons meet the [size and weight limits](#).
- Tickets are non-transferable. They are valid only for the personal use of the passenger(s) named on the ticket.
